ANNUAL MEETING (APCM)

The Annual Meeting of All Souls has been set for **Monday 19th October 2020 at 7.30 pm in St Nicholas Church, Austrey.** It will start with a short service of Evening Prayer. Places will be limited and you will need to book with the PCC Secretary (Alison Meredith) in the week prior to the meeting (between 12th and 19th October) and it will be helpful if this can be limited to one person per household, to allow as wide a representation as possible. Clearly all the above arrangements are provisional at this stage and will have to be changed if the government introduces new and tighter restrictions, in which case the meeting will be conducted virtually. Any changes will be notified via both the website and church noticeboards.
