## **PRAYERS**

Prayers for the World: We pray for our world still in the grip of the coronavirus pandemic, and as new variants are identified, especially those lands where high numbers of cases are still being recorded, with an inevitable rise in the death toll. We pray for strength and resilience for all those caring for the sick and the dying. We give thanks for the hope embodied in the roll-out of the vaccination programme, praying that there will be sufficient supplies to ensure a fair distribution across the world. We pray especially for all those missing the fellowship afforded by communal worship, particularly those who do not have internet access. In our Parish of All Souls we give thanks for the appointment of a new vicar, praying that she will be a source of inspiration and blessing.

Prayers for our Community: We pray for all those who reside or work in our parish, that you would continue to guard, guide and protect them in their daily lives. We give thanks for all the acts of kindness and support for those in need and pray for encouragement for these to continue. We pray especially for all the staff and children in our three village schools, that the return to face-to-face learning may be safely and successfully achieved.

Prayers for the sick: We ask for your love and healing touch to surround all who are ill or in pain at this time, especially those of our church family and others known to us, that they might know your loving presence and find healing and peace.

Prayers for the bereaved: We pray for all who mourn at this difficult time, lifting up especially Judy and family as they grieve the loss of Elsa. Comfort all who mourn, strengthen them in their sorrow and hold them in your loving arms.

**LIVE LENT 2021** - The Church of England has produced a booklet of daily bible readings, prayers and reflections for use from Ash Wednesday (17 February) to Easter Sunday (4 April). It is aimed at encouraging all Christians to think about their calling, how to share their faith and reflect on the difference Christ makes in our lives. Each week there is also an invitation to act upon the reflections studied. The reflections will also be available as a free app, via email, audio as well as through the Church of England's social media accounts.

**DAILY HOPE** -If you do not have internet access and as yet do not feel able to attend one of our live services, you might be interested in a **free** telephone service offered by the Church of England entitled "Daily Hope" which you can access by dialling **0800 804 8044**. There are a number of options offering hymns, prayers, reflections, as well as the opportunity to tune in to a full worship service. A new option using the # key is 'Sleep Well with Daily Hope', which consists of music and scripture passages designed to help both young and old unwind towards a good night's sleep.
